Thank you for purchasing your new 300 portable power station. Let's get started!



Please charge your 300 unit first before reading through this manual. You can
begin charging your 300 unit by opening the unit and installing the battery (or batteries), then connect positive and negative wires to battery terminals. After you have completed this, close the unit, and connect it to your electrical power supply by plugging it into a wall socket and connecting alligator clips to the terminal posts. Depending upon the batteries you are using, a normal charge duration is between 5-10 hours.





CHARGING WITH YOUR 300



RE-CHARGING WITH YOUR 300

Before using or storing your 300, plug into the wall socket until it is fully charged. If the display shows a capacity of less than 20%, connect to a power source as soon as possible. Power sources include: Car charger (approx. 5 hrs.) / Wall Socket (approx. 5 hrs.) / Solar panels (approx. 8-10 hours, depending on panel size and weather)

CHARGING FROM SOLAR OR FROM A WALL OUTLET

Charging using our solar panels

You will want to position your solar panel where it will get as much direct sunlight as possible. Our solar panel comes with two different adapter plugs. The first set is the cig socket adapter. First plug the cig socket adapter in the cig socket in your 300 station. Second, turn on the master switch and then turn on the cig socket switch. Now place the solar panel outside and you will be charging or maintaining the battery.

Another way to use this solar panel is by using the alligator clips. First, connect your alligator plug into the solar panel. Second, connect the red alligator clip onto the red terminal of your battery and the black alligator clip onto the black terminal of the battery. Set the solar panel outside and you are now charging your battery.

Charging using our AC wall charger

There are two ways you can charge your battery using our wall charger. First, open the station and disconnect the two wires attached to the battery. Second, connect the clips on the charger to the battery, red to red and black to black and then plug the other end into the wall outlet.

Or you can attach the alligator clips onto the matching terminals posts, red to red and black to black and then plug your wall charger into the wall outlet. Then turn on your master power switch on the station and then turn on the corresponding terminal post switch. To charge your battery.






TROUBLESHOOTING

Troubleshooting procedures:

- 1. Make sure your battery is fully charged by pressing our battery meter, which will show your percentage of charge.
- 2. Set check your battery connection by opening the station and make sure both connections are connected to the battery and that the red is connected to red and black to black.
- 3. Try resetting the circuit breaker. Make sure the circuit breaker is not tripped. If it is tripped, just push the lever and make sure it is in the down position.
- 4. If for any reason, a button on our station does not activate the lights, USB port or cig socket make sure the all the wires inside are securely connected.
